

Leggett Valley School Reopening FAQ Sheet

As COVID-19 numbers continue to decline and many schools are preparing to open across the state Leggett Valley School wants you to have the most current information on how our school will look when it does open.

Because Mendocino County has moved out of the purple tier and into the red tier the state is allowing K-12 grade school sites to open beginning now.

- 1) The school day shall start at 8:30 a.m. and be finished at 12:30 p.m.
Elementary will come to school every day Tuesday through Friday.
Middle School and High School will come to school every day Tuesday through Friday.
Return dates for each grade level are: K-1 4,5,6 March 23
 2-3 8,9 March 30
 7,10,11,12 April 13
- 2) All students and staff shall wear masks correctly while on the school campus.
- 3) Staff and students will keep physical distancing of 6 feet as much as possible. Where six feet distancing is not possible 4 feet will be the minimum. (This follows California Department of Health recommendations).
- 4) Morning meals will be grab and go and consumed outside on campus as much as possible. When that is not possible, they will be consumed in the cafeteria or classrooms keeping 6 ft physical distancing.
- 5) All lunch meals will be grab and go at the end of the school day and consumed at home.
- 6) Each elementary classroom will have two designated recess times that are unique to their classroom only. During these recess times classrooms will be disinfected. Middle School and High School will have one 15-minute break. Classrooms will be disinfected during that time.
- 7) All students will wash or sanitize their hands before entering the classroom after both recess times.
- 8) Parents are asked to wait in the car at bus stops while their students get on the bus and both students and parents are being asked to wear masks while waiting for the bus. Students will have temperature checks as they enter the bus. If they have a temperature then parents will take them home.
- 9) Students riding the bus will be in assigned seats with sufficient spacing, grouped by family and have partially to fully opened windows. The bus will also have extra masks available.
- 10) Parents and buses will drop off their students at the designated area near the cafeteria when coming on campus in the morning. If parents are dropping their students then these students will have their temperature checked before dropping their kids. If a student has a temperature then parents will take them home.

- 11) Parents shall wear masks when on campus and only be allowed to enter campus through the main office. The office secretary will meet parents at the main entrance to find out what the parent needs or wants. It is encouraged that parents do not enter campus unless absolutely necessary.
- 12) Each classroom will have partially to fully open windows, contact free thermometers, an air purifier, extra masks, hands-free soap dispensers, hands-free towel dispenser and hands-free hand sanitizer.
- 14) Students and staff will be tested on the first day they return. Testing after that will be systematic or at the request of the parent.

Tests are self-administered and can be done by even our kindergarteners. It is like picking your nose with a swab only you swipe the swab at the very start of the inside of your nose. Like an itch. Test has a 15-minute turn around on results and is 98% accurate.

- 15) If a parent chooses to have their student in school and then changes their mind the student will have to stay in distance learning through the remainder of the year. Students who choose in school cannot choose to take a day and distance learn. It is one or the other.
